PRE-SESSION VIDEO 1: UNDERSTANDING THE BASIC LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

This comprehensive session will discuss the requirements of Title IX and corollary laws, including:

- Defining and recognizing sexual harassment and assault, gender-based harassment, bullying and retaliation encompassed by Title IX;
- Defining and recognizing domestic violence, dating violence and stalking;
- Understanding the definitions used by the Office of Civil Rights;
- Civil liability standards established by the United States Supreme Court;
- Scope of the Title IX – on/off campus, employee and others; and
- The impact of alcohol.

PRE-SESSION VIDEO 2: LEGALLY REQUIRED POLICIES & TRAININGS

This session will focus on the legal requirements faced by your institution and explain steps that need to be taken to ensure compliance with those legal requirements.

- The role of the Title IX Coordinator;
- Responsibilities of institutional personnel in supervisory roles off campus;
- Required elements of a Title IX policy; integrated policies;
- Other required policies under Clery, SaVE Act & the Campus Sexual Assault Victims' Bill of Rights;
- Required vs. recommended trainings; and
- Who needs to be trained.

PRE-SESSION VIDEO 3: EFFECTIVE AND LEGALLY COMPLIANT RESPONSE STRATEGIES

This session will focus on formulating an effective response. Participants will learn about:

- Interim Actions;
 - Identifying Resources; and
 - Clery Act Requirements.
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
